MORNING TEA PAYMENTS				

As time moves on (far too quickly) changes come about that we need to which we need to adapt. The changes to payment methods and banking have brought about the need to change the methods by which we collect our payments.

As from this meeting members have two options for the payment of the \$5 morning tea meeting fee.

Option 1: Pay \$30 for your morning tea for the next twelve months.

Option 2: Pay \$5 at the door at each of the eleven meetings you attend in the next **12** months (no general meeting in December).

You have probably already worked out the best deal for regular attendees. Note: Members deemed "non-active" are not required to pay the \$30.

As from April 2024 cash and cheques will no longer be accepted for payments for morning tea or other club tours and events. Payments will need to be made via direct deposit into the club account.

Further, the annual fee for 2024 will consist of the \$40 membership fee (this has remained the same for the last 12 years) plus a \$30 annual charge for morning tea at the general meetings. Thus, the annual charge will be \$70 per member.
