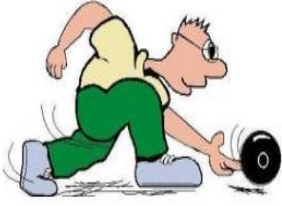
BOWLS FUN DAY
