### MAYFIELD GARDENS AND ABERCROMBIE HOUSE.

#### **BOOKINGS ARE NOW OPEN FOR THIS TRIP.**

This tour is open to both members, their partners and guests. On the first day we will visit the world-recognised Mayfield Gardens at Oberon. Mayfield is known as one of the loveliest gardens in the Southern Hemisphere. It is considered one of the best and largest cool climate gardens and should be amazing when we visit in early autumn.

Travel will be in individual cars from the Southern Highlands and will take about three hours

to Mayfield, with time to stop for morning tea. Lunch will be in the café on arrival at Mayfield Gardens and afterwards a shuttle bus will be provided after lunch to take us to the highest point of the gardens allowing an easier stroll back through the gardens.

We will then travel on to Bathurst for our overnight stay in the Heritage Inn in Bathurst and a group dinner is planned at a local restaurant for Monday evening.

On Tuesday, we will be treated to a visit to Abercrombie House. This grand country home is an 1870s cultural gem, one of the top three tourist attractions of Bathurst, was the home of the Morgan Family for half a century. We will visit the gardens, paths and outbuildings and explore the reception rooms, grand staircase, ballroom, first floor bedrooms and corridors. Included is a light luncheon before we head back to the Southern Highlands.
